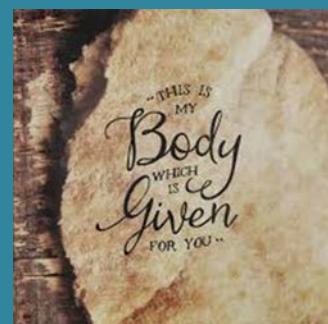
BAPTISM

- Couple must see a Priest or Deacon six months prior to proposed date.

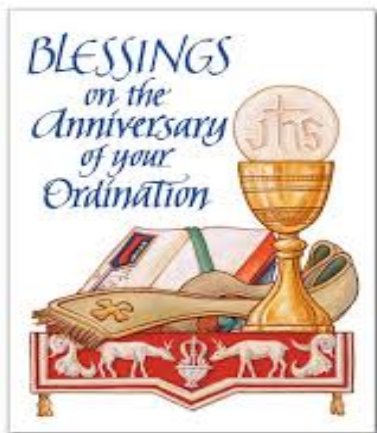

PRAYER CORNER

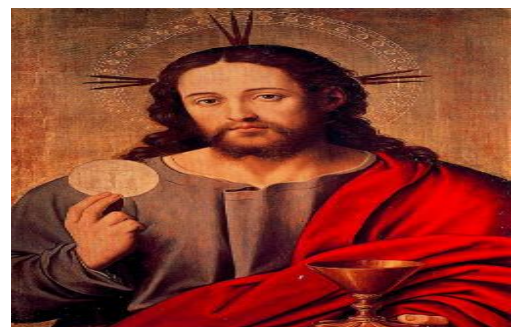
This is the truth each Christians learns, Bread into his flesh he turns, To his precious blood the wine.

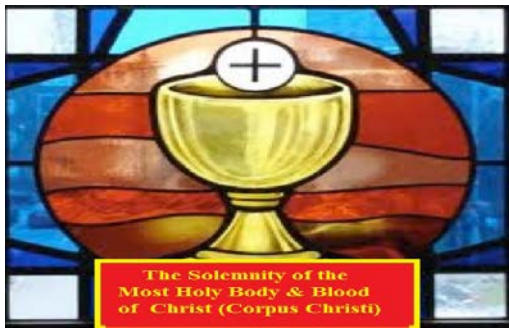
Sight has fail'd, nor thought conceives, But a dauntless faith believes, Resting on a pow'r divine.
