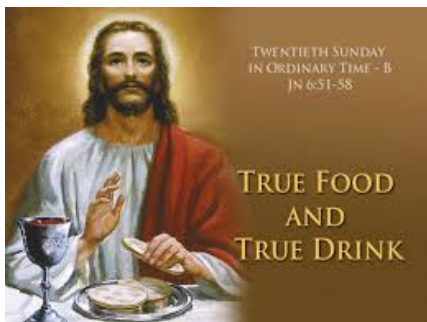

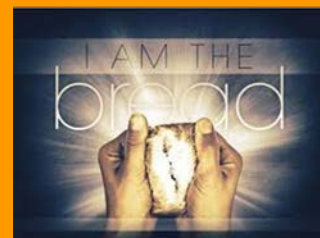
BAPTISM

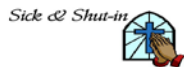


AUGUST 19, 2018
