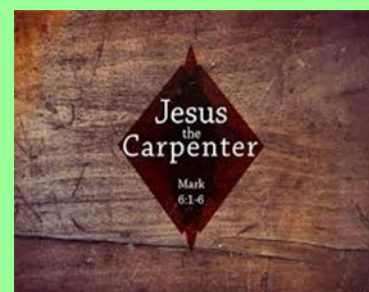
BAPTISM

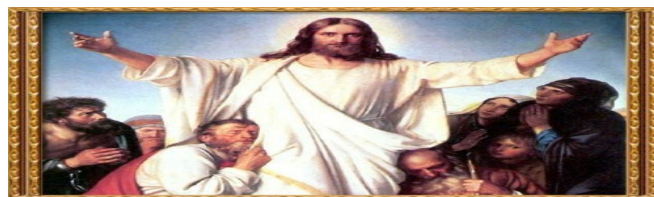

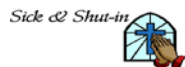

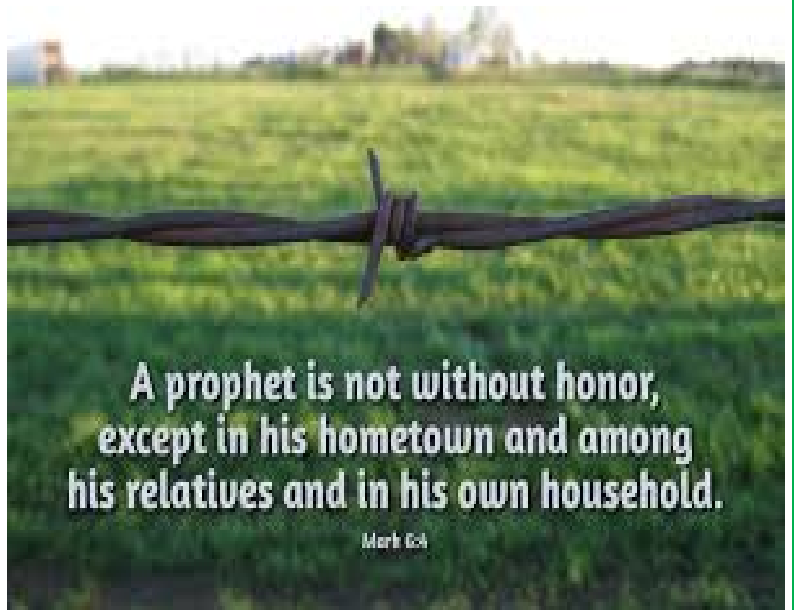
