### REQUIREMENTS/PROCEDURES

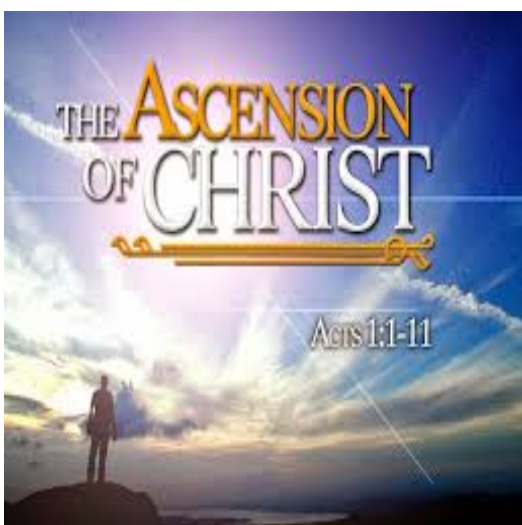
- Member of Our Lady Star of the Sea

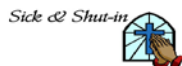
