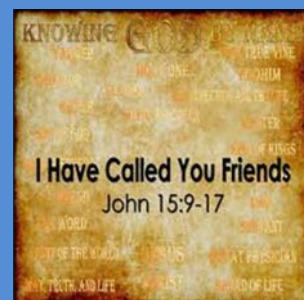
BAPTISM

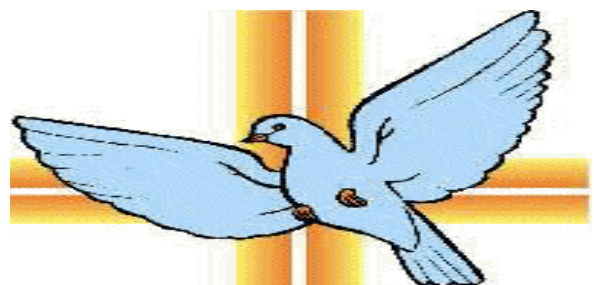
