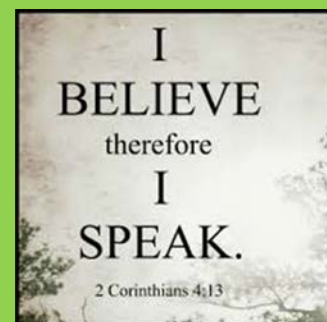
BAPTISM

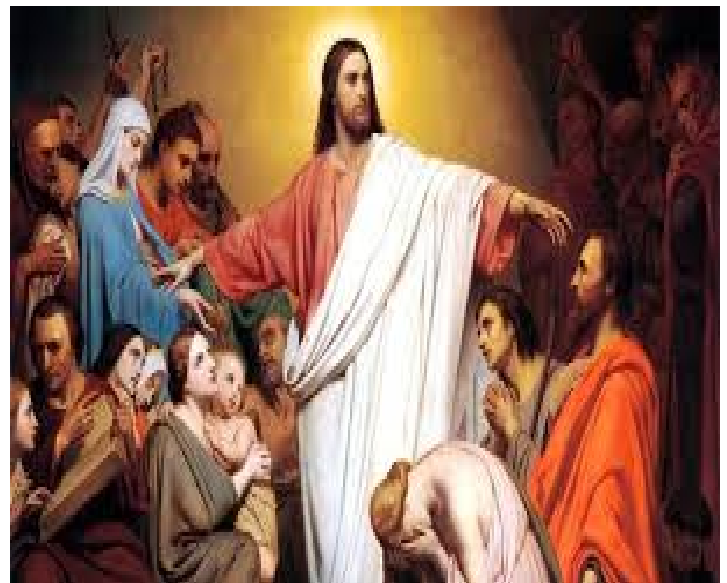
