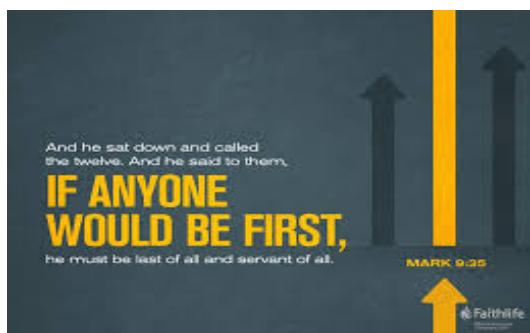

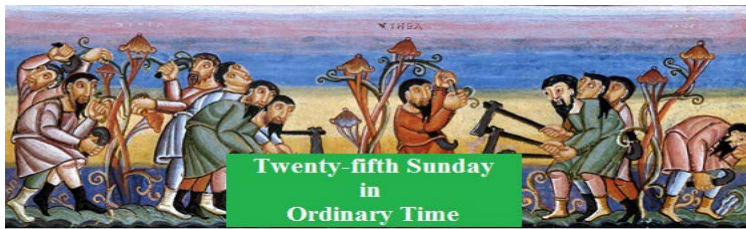
### PRAYER CORNER
